
A FREE PATTERN FROM:

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THE STIFF STUFF CUFF BRACELET

- 1) Cut a piece of Lacy's Stiff Stuff 8 1/2 inches long and 1 1/8 inches wide.
- 2) Knot one end of the thread and thread through the Stiff Stuff close to the edge. Thread on seven size 11 seed beads and stitch down. Bead both edges of one color section. Fill this section in with beads, always threading on seven beads at a time.
- The fill-in beads may be stitched in any direction needed to completely fill with bead loops.
- Bead the remainder of the cuff, one color section at a time. Bead until the cuff fits comfortably around your wrist.
- 5) Cut excess Stiff Stuff away.
- Securely stitch one end of a three-loop slide lock clasp to each end of your cuff bracelet.
- 7) Cut a piece of leather 1 1/8 inches wide and the length of your bracelet. Apply a thin layer of E-6000 glue to the back of the beadwork and press the leather in place.
- To give your cuff bracelet a professional finish, whip stitch the leather to the bracelet around all edges.
